Using voice to achieve a sustainable warehouse



Introduction

Using voice




Voice is often a consideration for those looking to "go green" in the warehouse, as it requires almost zero paper to set up, and no paper at all to be functional.

With voice, the need for pick lists is completely removed, as workers get all of their instructions from a headset. Rather than referring to a list and moving through the warehouse, the voice software will guide your worker on the optimal path through the warehouse, verifying their location and pick amounts as they go. This not only removes paper entirely from the process, but also allows them to move more quickly and accurately through their picking.

Additionally, a series of check digits identifies a location, and doesn't need to change as inventory moves in and out of the different locations in your warehouse. This means you only need to print once to set up a location, and only print additional labels if you expand or rearrange the racks.

The only investment voice requires is in the headsets and talkmans, both of which operate on rechargeable batteries and are made to have long lives in the warehouse environment.

Removing paper

The first step in most sustainability initiatives will be to reduce paper. The easiest way this is done is by removing the need for paper pick lists. For many operations, this will be the biggest source of waste, as each pick list can be several pages long for every worker, and often end up in the trash or scattered on the warehouse floor.

There is also an additional benefit to removing paperremoving the ink that it takes to print. Ink cartridges can be a large cost for those operations that rely on paper, and can have a lot of waste associated with them. By removing the need to print you can take ink costs, both in dollars and environmental impact, out of the equation.

Removing bar codes

Although slightly easier on the environment, bar codes can still use a significant amount of ink and paper to print. Depending on the process the warehouse utilizes, there may still be pick lists involved, and each new SKU requires a new label to be printed and posted around the warehouse.

Removing lights

A common argument in favor of lights is that they, like voice, remove the need for paper in the warehouse. But in order to maintain functionality, regular maintenance needs to be performed on the lights, wires, and screens involved with voice. All of these pieces have components that are non-recyclable, making sustainability an issue with this system.
